

ORDINANCE NO. 162

PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF BRIAR ALLEY AS A
PUBLIC HIGHWAY.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same, that Briar Alley extending from the north side of Hershberger Street to the south side of Bluff Street, and running between Lots Nos. 850 and 851 on the plan of Southmont laid out by C.P. Collins, March 5, 1907 for Cambria Land and Improvement Company Limited, in the Borough of Southmont, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
