Mr. Rodgers stated the intent of the meeting was to discuss the possibility of hiring Stiffler McGraw as consultants to review the sanitary sewer data and project proposed by The EADS Group. A discussion was held explaining the history of the inflow and infiltration issues in Southmont Borough and the directives given by Johnstown Redevelopment Authority. The representatives from Stiffler McGraw stated they would be willing to provide the consultation noting The EADS Group would need to be made aware of the intentions to obtain a second opinion. The engineers could not give an immediate answer to our problems until they have reviewed the data. They will provide an estimate for the second opinion and a fee schedule to review. One question could not be answered by Southmont Borough which was if there is an inter-municipal agreement between JRA and Southmont? They also indicated that flow monitoring would be needed and they have their own meters.
