

ORDINANCE NO. 61

ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS, PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF A PORTION OF STATE STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA, AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR THE SAID GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID PORTION OF STATE STREET.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and the same hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that that portion of State Street from its intersection with Leon Street to its intersection with Helen Street within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County Pa., shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, drained, curbed and paved with a reinforced cement concrete pavement or a concrete Base with a Bituminous Surface pavement, together with all necessary sanitary sewers, storm sewers, manholes, drop inlets and all other work incidental thereto, in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer, as prayed for by the petition of the property owners acknowledged the 11th day of February A.D. 1927.

Section 2. That the width of said portion of State Street from its intersection with Leon Street to its intersection with Helen Street shall be established and the same hereby is established at sixty feet; that the widths of the roadway and sidewalks shall be established and the same hereby are established at twenty-four feet from face to face of curb for roadway, and eighteen feet from face of curb to property line for sidewalks.

Section 3. That the committee on highways and sewers shall be authorized and hereby are authorized to proceed with the advertisements and completion of said work on the foot front plan in accordance with the petition on file for the improvements of said portion of State Street.

Section 4. That one-third of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving, and improving of said portion of State Street, together with all incidental work thereto, shall be appropriated and the same hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer authorized to make payments of same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Boro

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engineer and approved by the Borough Council.

Section 5. That two-thirds of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of State Street, together with all incidental work thereto, and the total cost of all curbing and sanitary sewer, as provided for by the Borough Ordinance, shall be assessed and the same hereby is assessed on the foot front plan to the abutting property owners.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
