

ORDINANCE NO. 187

PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF A PORTION OF PLUM ALLEY
AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that Plum Alley, from its intersection with the northerly line of Helen Street to its intersection with the southerly line of Floyd Street and running back between Lot No. 334 and Lot No. 335 on the Plan of Southmont laid out by C.P. Collins, March 5, 1907 for Cambria Land and Improvement Company Limited shall be accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
