ORDINANCE NO. 308

ORDINANCE OF SOUTHMONT BOROUGH, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1981, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 307 PASSED DECEMBER 16, 1980

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of Southmont Borough, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within said municipality subject to taxation for the fiscal year 1981 as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of sixteen and seventeen one-hundredths (16.17) of a mill on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of sixteen and seventeen one-hundredths (16.17) of a mill.

SECTION 2. That for the expenses, salaries and wages for the fiscal year 1981, amounts are appropriated from the revenues available for the said year for the purposes set forth and itemized in the Budget Form on file in the Borough Office and as passed by the Borough Council.

SECTION 3. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
