

ORDINANCE NO. 264

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1971, AND FIXING SALARIES AND WAGE RATES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1971, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of twelve (12) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of twelve (12) mills.

SECTION 2. That salaries and wages be fixed for the fiscal year 1971 as follows:

Hospitalization for all regular employes to be paid by Borough if requested.

SECTION 3. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
