

ORDINANCE NO. 170

The Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordaines as follows:

Section 1. Edward Street from the end of the present paving to Dell Street, to a width of twelve (12) feet on either side of the center line.

Section 2. The President of Council and the Borough Secretary are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in the name of the Borough for the whole or any part of said work or for the materials or labor connected therewith with such parties and upon such terms as the Council may deem or agree upon.

Section 3. The Borough Engineer is hereby designated as the person in charge of said work with full power to work for the Borough in all things connected with said work and to estimate assessments.

Section 4. The costs and expenses of the entire work hereby shall be paid by the Borough of Southmont and the owners of the real estate abutting or bounding on said street in accordance with Section 1712 of the Borough Code as amended. One third of said costs and expenses shall be paid by the Borough and the same is hereby appropriated therefore out of the funds now or hereafter in the Treasury and two thirds of said costs and expenses shall be paid by the owners of real estate bounding or abutting on said street and the same is hereby assessed according to the foot front rule, and the assessments appropriated therefore.

Section 5. Whatever curbing and/or guttering shall be necessary in the opinion of the Borough Engineer, to make a complete job shall be likewise constructed, and the entire cost thereof shall be assessed against the abutting properties according to the foot front rule.

Ordinance passes in Council the 18th day of April, 1955.
