

ORDINANCE NO. 424

**PROVIDING FOR A MAXIMUM SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON THE STREETS OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT AND AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF SIGNS, PROVIDING FOR PARKING, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF WHICH SHALL AMEND SOUTHMONT BOROUGH ORDINANCES NO. 111, 128 AND 410**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Southmont has enacted Ordinances for the placement of signs, providing for parking, and providing for penalties for violations of ordinances concerning the placement of signs; and


WHEREAS, the Borough of Southmont by Ordinance No. 410 which amends Ordinances No. 111 and 128 provided for the placement of signs by street sign, side of street and location of sign.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Southmont that Section 3 and Section 4 of Ordinance 410 is amended to include the placement of signs as indicated on Exhibit "A" attached to the Ordinance.

1. Violations and Penalties: Any person violating any part of this ordinance shall pay a fine, the costs of prosecution, or in default of payment of the fine, shall be committed to prison under the penalties set forth in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, Purdons Statutes as Amended, which is incorporated herein.
