

ORDINANCE NO. 200

PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR THE CONNECTION OF AND REPAIRS TO PRIVATE SEWERS WITH THE BOROUGH SEWER SYSTEMS REQUIRING INSPECTION THEREOF AND GRANTING AUTHORITY FOR THE BOROUGH ENGINEER OR HIS AGENT TO GO ON PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR SAID PURPOSES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

- Section 1. The word "person" as used in this ordinance shall mean any natural person association, partnership, firm or corporation. The singular shall include the plural and masculine shall include the feminine and neuter.
- Section 2. The word "sewer" as used in this ordinance shall mean any pipes or drainage facilities for the discharge of waste matter or storm run-off and shall include both what are known as sanitary sewers and storm sewers.
- Section 3. From and after the enactment of this ordinance no person shall make or cause to be made any connection of a sewer from any property with the sewer system of the Borough or repair to a sewer main unless and until he has fulfilled all of the following conditions:
- (a) He shall notify the Borough Engineer of his intention to make such connection or repairs.
 - (b) He shall give the Borough Engineer at least forty eight (48) hours notice of the time when such connection or repairs shall be made, in order that the Borough Engineer or his authorized agent shall have the opportunity to inspect the same.
 - (c) He shall make such connection or repairs in accordance with the specifications and directions which the Borough Engineer shall from time to time adopt for proper sewer connections, or repairs.
- Section 4. No person shall cover over any connection of a private sewer with the Borough sewer system or repairs to a sewer main until the Borough Engineer or his authorized agent shall have inspected the same and authorized the same to be covered over.
- Section 5. The Borough Engineer or his agent is granted permission at reasonable times to go upon private property for the purpose of inspecting sewer connections made or being made with the sewer system of the Borough of repairs to or being made to any sewer main.
- Section 6. Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than fifty (\$50.00) dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than (10) days. Provided that continuance of a violation for one week after notice or prosecution thereof shall constitute a separate offence for each week the violation continues.
- Section 7. All ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
