

ORDINANCE NO. 15

ACCEPTING HENRY ALLEY AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE
BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town
Council of the Borough Of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa.,
and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of
the same, that Henry Alley, between Orchard Street and
Diamond Boulevard, as shown on the Borough map, shall be
and the same is hereby accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the
same hereby are repealed.
