

ORDINANCE NO. 50

ACCEPTING WEAVER COURT IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT GAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS AND WIDENING SAID HIGHWAY, PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAME, AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR THE SAID GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID WEAVER COURT.

- Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of Southmont Borough, Cambria County, Pa., and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that Weaver Court from its intersection with Gardner Street to its intersection with Millcreek Road within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.
- Section 2. That the width of said Weaver Court shall be established and the same hereby is established at forty (40) feet; that the width of the roadway and sidewalks shall be established and the same hereby are established at twenty (20) feet from face to face of curb for roadway and ten (10) feet from face of curb to property line for sidewalks.
- Section 3. That a strip of ground four (4) feet in width, extending along the northeasterly side of Weaver Court from the intersection of Gardner Street to the intersection of Millcreek Road, being a portion of land owned by Telford Lewis, shall be condemned and appropriated and the same hereby is condemned and appropriated for highway purposes, which added to the original dedicated width of Weaver Court or thirty-six (36) feet provides for the established width of forty (40) feet.
- Section 4. That Weaver Court from its intersection with Gardner Street to its intersection with Millcreek Road, including the necessary highway intersections and returns shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, drained, curbed and paved with a reinforced cement concrete pavement together with all necessary sanitary sewers, storm sewers, manholes, drop inlets and all other work incidental thereto, in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer, as prayed for by the petition of the property owners, acknowledged on the 14th day of December A.D. 1925.
- Section 5. That the committee on highways and sewers shall be authorized and hereby are authorized to proceed with the advertisements and completion of said work on the foot front plan in accordance with the petition on file for the improvements of said Weaver Court.
- Section 6. That one-third of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said Weaver Court together with all incidental work thereto shall be appropriated and hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer is authorized to make payments of same from time to time on estimated prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by the Borough Council.
- Section 7. That two-thirds of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said Weaver Court together with all incidental work thereto, and the total cost of all curbing and sanitary sewer, as provided by the Borough Ordinance shall be assessed and the same hereby is assessed on the foot front plan to the abutting property owners.

Section 8. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby repealed.
