

ORDINANCE NO. 82

ACCEPTING A PORTION OF DAHLIA STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA, AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ESTABLISHING THE WIDTHS, PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAME, TOGETHER WITH ALL SANITARY SEWERS AND INCIDENTAL WORK AND APPROPRIATING THE MONEY FOR SAID GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, PAVING AND IMPROVING OF SAID PORTION OF DAHLIA STREET.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa.. and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that that portion of Dahlia Street from its intersection with the southerly side of Queen Street Extended to its intersection with the northerly side of King Street Extended at right angles, within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa.. shall be accepted and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway.

Section 2. That the width of said portion of Dahlia Street shall be established and the same hereby is established at sixty feet; that the widths of the roadway and sidewalks shall be established and the same hereby are established at twenty-four feet from face of curb to face of curb for roadway, and eighteen feet from face of curb to property line for sidewalks.

Section 3. That said portion of Dahlia Street from its intersection with the southerly side of Queen Street Extended to its intersection with the northerly side of King Street Extended at right angles, including the necessary highway intersections and returns, shall be and the same hereby is authorized to be graded, drained, curbed and paved with a reinforced cement concrete pavement or a concrete base with a Bituminous surface, together with all necessary sanitary sewer, storm sewer, manholes, drop inlets and other work incidental thereto in accordance with the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineers, as prayed for by a petition of a majority of the property owners in interest and in number abutting on said portion of Dahlia Street, acknowledged on the 11th day of March A.D. 1929.

Section 4. That the Committee on Highways and Sewers shall be authorized and hereby is authorized to proceed with the advertisements and completion of said work on the foot front plan in accordance with the petition on file for the improvements of said portion of Dahlia Street.

Section 5. That one-third of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of Dahlia St. together with all incidental work thereto, shall be appropriated and the same hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer authorized to make payments of same from time to time on estimates prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by the Borough Council.

Section 6. That two-thirds of the total cost and expense of grading, draining, paving and improving of said portion of Dahlia St. together with all incidental work thereto as provided by the Borough Ordinance shall be assessed on the foot front plan to the abutting property owners.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
