

ORDINANCE NO. 34

LAYING OUT AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SECTIONS OF SANITARY SEWER, APPROPRIATING THE MONEY, CONDEMNING RIGHT-OF-WAYS AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF VIEWERS.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that sections of sanitary sewer within the limits of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pa., shall be constructed and the same hereby are authorized to be constructed and the committee on highways and sewers shall be authorized and hereby are authorized to proceed with said work in accordance with the general ordinances and the plans, specifications and directions of the Borough Engineer, as follows:

From the present manhole on Fisher Street through private property to the intersection of Wonder Street and State Street.

From the intersection of Wonder Street and State Street to the manhole at the intersection of Pear Alley.

From the end of the present sewer at Lot 275 on State Street to the end of the present sewer at Lot 263 on State Street.

From the intersection of Leila Street and Leon Court on Leon Court to the intersection of Plum Alley.

From the intersection of Leon Court and Plum Alley on Plum Alley to the intersection of the line between lots 412 and 413.

From the intersection of the line between lots 412 and 413 and Plum Alley on the line between lots 412 and 413 to the intersection of Mabel Street.

From the intersection of the line between Lots 412 and 413 and Mabel Street to the intersection of Helen Street.

From the intersection of Mabel Street and Helen Street on Helen Street to the intersection of the present sewer from Hillcrest Avenue.

Section 2. That the cost of constructing said sanitary sewers shall be appropriated and the same hereby is appropriated and the Borough Treasurer authorized to make payment on same from time to time on estimates or accounts prepared by the Borough Engineer approved by the Borough Council, and the Borough Engineer shall be authorized and hereby is authorized to make assessments to the property owners abutting on said sewers to be constructed as provided in the general ordinances.

Section 3. That viewers be appointed according to law to assess damages done and benefits occurring, if any, by the reason of laying out, opening, constructing and maintaining said sanitary sewer where the same passes through private property if the same cannot be amiably agreed upon by the Borough of Southmont and the property owners affected by said improvements.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are repealed.

Passes finally in Council this 14th day of July A.D. 1924.
