

PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF HANNAH ALLEY AND THE  
OPENING OF AN ALLEY TO EXTEND FROM MARION STREET IN AN  
EASTERLY DIRECTION TO CLERN ALLEY.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the  
Borough of Southmont, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby en-  
acted and ordained by the authority of the same:

That the following described alley to wit: All that certain piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Borough of Southmont, formerly Township of Upper Yoder, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point on Marion Street at the north west corner of lot No. 32 on the plan known as Southmont Addition No. one, as laid out by A.W. Swarts, and remaining of record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, in and for Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book Volume 1 page 38; thence along the easterly side of Marion Street north 20 degrees one minute west 18.48 feet to a point, corner of lot No. 2; thence along the south-erly lines of Lots Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5 and along a portion of lot No. 6; south 79 degrees 57 minutes east a distance of 178.11 feet to a point on line of Lot No. 6; and the intersection of Clerm Alley and Hannah Alley; thence across Hannah Alley south 12 degrees 21 minutes east 17.3 feet to a point at the intersection of the northeast corner of Lot No. 32 above mentioned; thence along line of Lot No. 32 north 79 degrees 57 minutes west 175.42 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, it being the portion of said Hannah Alley extend- ing from Marion Street in an easterly direction to its inter- section with Clerm Alley, Be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. In lieu of the above described portion of Hannah Alley which is hereby vacated, there is hereby opened to the use of the public, the following described alley, to wit:

All That Certain piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Borough, County and State of the aforesaid, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point on

Marion Street; at the northwestern corner of Lot No. 22 of the plan above mentioned; thence along Marion Street north 20 degrees one minute west 16.14 feet to a point on line of Lot No. 23; thence through Lot No. 23 north 77 degrees 39 minutes east a distance of 106.36 feet to Clern Alley; thence along the line of Clern Alley south 12 degrees 21 minutes east 16 feet to a point at the north eastern corner of Lot No. 22 south 77 degrees 39 minutes west 104.21 feet to Marion Street, the place of beginning, and being a sixteen foot wide strip of land taken from the southerly portion of Lot No. 23 for its entire length, and extending from Marion Street in an easterly direction to Clern Alley.

Passed finally in Council, the 12th day of December A.D. 1921.
