

ORDINANCE NO. 203

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHMONT, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A SEWAGE SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE JOHNSTOWN MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, AND DIRECTING THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE SOUTHMONT BOROUGH COUNCIL TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT.

Whereas, the Johnstown Municipal Authority has negotiated a sewage service agreement for the transportation and treatment of certain acceptable sewage and industrial waste of the inhabitants of the Borough of Southmont by the Johnstown Municipal Authority at the rates and charges provided for in said Agreement; and

Whereas, it is the opinion of the Southmont Borough Council that the Agreement is in the best interest of the citizens of the Borough of Southmont.

Now, therefore, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Southmont, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted of authority of same;

Section 1. The Borough Council shall enter into a Sewage Service Agreement with the Johnstown Municipal Authority upon substantially the terms, conditions and covenants set forth in the form of a presented Service Agreement read at this meeting, and which is hereby in all respects approved.

Section 2. The President of the Southmont Borough Council is hereby directed to execute on behalf of the Borough, the Sewage Service Agreement, substantially in the form of the said Service Agreement which when executed, shall be attested to by the Secretary.

Ordained and enacted finally into law by the Southmont Borough Council this 26th day of September, 1960.
